

Thornton Police investigate armed robbery, shooting

The Thornton Police Department is investigating an armed robbery and shooting that occurred on Jan. 18 at an apartment complex near the 2500 block of East 104th Avenue.

Officers were dispatched to the area at 2:40 a.m. after receiving reports of a burglary in progress and gunfire. Upon arrival, officers located a 25-year-old male suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim, identified as the brother of the apartment resident, was transported to a nearby hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

The investigation revealed that the apartment resident was not home at the time of the burglary but was alerted to movement outside the unit by a home security camera. The suspect, however, covered the camera before continuing with the crime. The resident contacted his brother, who lives in the same complex, to check on the apartment. Upon arrival, the victim encountered the suspect, who then shot him and fled the scene with valuables from the apartment.

Detectives have obtained photos of the suspect from the home camera, which are included below. Detectives believe this to be an isolated incident, but the investigation is ongoing.

Further information will be released if there are significant developments in the case.
